

Grouping of articles/variants within a product group

To facilitate the environmental assessment of your building materials at SundaHus, it is important that products with multiple articles or variants are grouped correctly. Below is a clarification on how this should be done:

Articles must have the same:

- Main name
- Function

This mainly affects the BK04 and BSAB classification systems, where each article/variant must have the same code to be included in the same assessment.

- Content
- Documentation

Minor variations in composition

We allow differences in composition of up to <2% by weight between different items/variants within the same product, provided that the above requirements are met.

Example:

If a product consists of steel fittings with different surface treatments, for example galvanized and powder coated, these can be included in the same assessment as long as the surface treatment makes up less than 2% of the product's total weight. SundaHus will then assesses both surface treatments and their impact.

Important: If a surface treatment gets a lower assessment, it will affect all articles in the assessment. The manufacturer/supplier will then have the option to split the assessment to avoid this.
